- 3. 4-Year Bachelor's Degree (Honours with Research) with Single Major in Arts/Science/Commerce (in 8 semesters with 166 Credits)

Students will have to complete research project of 12 Credits in their Major area(s) of study in the 4th Year. The Eligibility condition of doing the UG (Honours with Research) is minimum 75% marks, obtained in the first six semesters.
