Admission to the 4-Year U.G. Single Major & 3-Year Multi-Disciplinary Programme for the session 2023-2024

It is notified for the information of all concerned that the college generally offers the following UG Programme from the session 2023-2024, maintaining the Curriculum & Credit Framework of Vidyasagar University in compliance with National Education Policy 2020.

UG PROGRAMMES OFFERED:

SINGLE MAJOR PROGRAMME

1. 3-Year Bachelor's Degree Programme with Single Major in Arts/Science/Commerce
(in 6 semesters with 126 Credits)

2. 4-Year Bachelor's Degree (Honours) with Single Major in Arts/Science/Commerce
(in 8 semesters with 166 Credits)

3. 4-Year Bachelor's Degree (Honours with Research) with Single Major in Arts/Science/Commerce
(in 8 semesters with 166 Credits)

Students will have to complete research project of 12 Credits in their Major area(s) of study in the 4th Year. The Eligibility condition of doing the UG (Honours with Research) is minimum 75% marks, obtained in the first six semesters.

NOTE: Single Major Course refers to a discipline/subject of main focus and the degree will be awarded in that discipline (i.e. B.A. Single Major in Bengali, B.Sc. Single Major in Physics and so on).

MULTI-DISCIPLINARY PROGRAMME

4. 3-Year Bachelor's Degree in Multi-Disciplinary Programme in Arts/Science/Commerce
(in 6 semesters with 126 Credits)

NOTE: Multi-Disciplinary Programme refers to a bunch of Major & Minor discipline/subject as per the table of Multi-Disciplinary Programme and the degree will be awarded in different Multi-Disciplinary Programme (i.e. B.A. in Humanities, B.Sc. in Physical Science and so on).

Apart from this, the following Awards will be awarded to the students who are willing to exit from the course of study:

- UG Certificate after completing 1 year of study (in 2 semesters with 40 Credits + Community Service of 4 Credits)
- UG Diploma after completing 2 years of study (in 4 semesters with 86 Credits)

Initially in this session (2023-2024), the college invites the Application Form from the eligible students for Admission in:

- ❖ Bachelor's Degree in Single Major Course in Arts/Science/Commerce
- ❖ Bachelor's Degree in Multi-Disciplinary Programme in Arts/Science/Commerce

The candidates who have passed the H.S./Equivalent Examination in 2023 or 2022 or 2021 will be admitted to the U.G. 4-Year Single Major & 3-Year Multidisciplinary Programme 1st Semester for the academic session 2023 -2024. No student will be allowed for admission into 1st Semester who passed HS Examination in or before 2020 as per UG regulation of the University.

(1) APPLICATION THROUGH ONLINE SYSTEM :

All the candidates have to apply through Online (College Website : www.mahishadalrajcollege.com) for admission to the 4-Year B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com./ Industrial Chemistry/ B.C.A (Single Major & Multidisciplinary Programme) and 1st Semester for the session 2023-2024.

(2) ADMISSION AND PAYMENT THROUGH E-COUNSELLING AND ONLINE SYSTEM :

After Publishing of Final Merit List, the Phase wise E-COUNSELLING LIST will be published as per the Admission Notice. The Selected candidates will have to scan original copies of M.P. Admit, H.S. Admit, H.S. Marksheet, Caste Certificate, PH Certificate, EWS Certificate etc. and upload it to the portal (Max size : 100 kb and in jpg format) and pay the Admission Fees within the stipulated date(s) positively. All the Admission will be done through E-Counselling and Admission Fees have to pay through online process (using Credit/Debit Card/Net Banking). Candidates are advised to follow the Admission/E-counselling Notice in regular basis.

They are also advised to check the Admission Payment Status and if any discrepancies arise in this regard they will have to contact with the college office within the admission date positively. No objection will be entertained after the admission date.

NOTE : If a candidate is already admitted in any subject and further selected for admission in another subject through next phase E-counselling, then an OTP will be send to his/her mobile number for cancellation of previous admission. At first he/she will has to cancel his/her previous admission, and then he/she will be able to admit in the next admission. No Fees will be adjusted at the time of further admission. The Fees of previous admission (after claiming by him/her) will be refunded from the college cash counter on the notified dates

An applicant can apply for maximum 01 Multidisciplinary Programme (B.A. in Humanities / B.A. in Social Science/ B.Sc. in Life Science/ B.Sc. in Physical Science/ B.Sc. in Math. & Comp. Sc.) in a Single Form. For more than 01 Multidisciplinary Programme Course he/she has to apply through another Form.

In addition, they will have to study any Two Subjects [maximum one Subject from one group of A B C D E F, as per Minor-1 and Minor-2 table, mentioned below (except the Single Major Subject)] as Minor-1 and Minor-2 alternatively in different Eight semesters, 02 AEC Courses in different Two semesters (English Communication in 1st & 3rd Sem. and Bengali/Hindi Communication in 2nd Sem. & 4th Sem.), 03 SEC Courses (notified later on) in different Three semesters, Three Multidisciplinary Subject (as per Multidisciplinary Course/Subject table*, mentioned below) in different Three semesters, 02 Value Added Courses (ENVS in 1st Sem. & Human Rights/Yoga and Wellness/ Disaster Management in 2nd Sem.), participate in 02 Summer Internship Courses in different Two semesters (one in 2nd Sem. and other in 4th Sem.) along with additional 03 Major Electives or 02 Research Papers during Four years.

In addition, they will have to study any Two Subjects [maximum one Subject from one group of A B C D E F, as per Minor-1 and Minor-2 table, mentioned above (except the Single Major Subject)] as Minor-1 and Minor-2 alternatively in different Eight semesters, 02 AEC Courses in different Two semesters (English Communication in 1st & 3rd Sem. and Bengali/Hindi Communication in 2nd Sem. & 4th Sem.), 03 SEC Courses (notified later on) in different Three semesters, Three Multidisciplinary Course/Subject (as per Multidisciplinary Subject table*, mentioned above) in different Three semesters, 02 Value Added Courses (ENVS in 1st Sem. & Human Rights/Yoga and Wellness/ Disaster Management in 2nd Sem.), participate in 02 Summer Internship Courses in different Two semesters (one in 2nd Sem. and other in 4th Sem.) along with additional 03 Major Electives or 02 Research Papers during Four years.


