Admission to the B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com. (Honours, General & Major) & BCA Courses for the session 2018-2019

It is notified for the information of all concerned that the candidates who have passed the H.S./Equivalent Examination in 2018 or 2017 or 2016 will be admitted to the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. (Hons., Gen. & Major) & BCA 1st Semester for the academic session 2018 -2019 as per norms. No student will be allowed for admission into 1st Semester who passed HS Examination in 2015 as per UG regulation.

(A) APPLICATION THROUGH ONLINE SYSTEM :

All the candidates have to apply through Online (College Website : www.mahishadalrajcollege.com) for admission to the B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com. (Honours, General & Major) & BCA Courses 1st Semester for the session 2018-2019

(B) Read the instructions and be sure of the eligibility for applying in different courses (see **Application Procedure, Eligibility Criteria, Admission Notice, Subject Combination Table and Intake Capacity**) very carefully before submission of Application Form.

(C) An applicant can apply for maximum 03 Honours Subjects in a Single Form. For more than 3 Honours Subjects he/she has to apply through another Form. An applicant can apply for maximum 1 General Course (B.A./B.Sc./B.Com) in a Single Form. For more than 01 General Course he/she has to apply through another Form.

(D) SUBJECT CHOICE :

For B.A./B.Sc. Honours Course : The Honours candidates have to select One Hons. Subject, Two Generic Subjects (*one for 1st & 2nd Sem and other for 3rd & 4th Sem.*) and One Compulsory Subject (AECC).

For B.Com (Hons.) Course : The candidates of B.Com. (Hons.) have to select "Accountancy" as Honours Subject and Select "Commerce Generic" for Two Generic Subjects and One Compulsory Subject (AECC).

For B.A./B.Com General Course : The B.A./B.Com. General candidates have to select Two DSC Subjects, One Generic Subject (for 5th & 6th Sem.), Two Language Core Subject (*English for 1st & 3rd Sem. and Bengali/Hindi for 2nd & 4th Sem.*) and One AECC Subject. NOTE : B.Com General candidates have to select "Commerce Subject" for DSC-1, DSC-2 and Generic subjects.

The Degree will be awarded on 1st choice subject (DSC-1).

Example : If a student select History (DSC-1), Sanskrit (DSC-2), Philosophy (Generic), English (Language) and Bengali Communication (AECC). **Then the Degree will be awarded as "B.A. Gen. with History"**

In addition, He/she has to study SEC subjects (related to DSE-1) and DSE subjects (related to DSE-1 & DSE-2) in different semester.

For B.Sc. General Course : The B.Sc. General candidates have to select Three DSC Subjects, and One AECC Subject.

The Degree will be awarded on 1st choice subject (DSC-1).

Example : If a student select Chemistry (DSC-1), Mathematics (DSC-2), Computer Science (DSC-3) and Bengali Communication (AECC) **Then the Degree will be awarded as "B.Sc. Gen. with Chemistry"**

In addition, He/she has to study SEC subjects (related to DSE-1) and DSE subjects (related to DSE-1 & DSE-2) in different semester.

For Industrial Chemistry : The candidates of Industrial Chemistry (Major) have to select "Industrial Chemistry" as Major Subject, Two Elective Subjects and One Compulsory Subject (AECC) as per the Subject Combination Table.

Subject*) in different Two semesters and 04 DSE Courses (*related with Hons. Subject*) in different Two semesters during three years.

In addition they have to study two papers of One Generic Subject (*other than Core Subjects from A B C D E F G column, mentioned below in 5th & 6th Sem.*), different 02 AECC Courses in different Two semesters (*Bengali/English/Hindi Communication in 1st Sem. and Environmental Studies in 2nd Sem.*), 04 SEC Courses (*related with DSC-1*) in different Four semesters, 02 papers each from a list of DSE courses based on the different two discipline of choice (*related with DSC-1 & DSC-2*) in different Two semesters during three years.

Students of B.Sc. General Course have to study 12 Core Courses/papers. In which 04 Core Papers each in 03 Subjects (*maximum one Subject from one group of A B C D E F G, mentioned below*). In addition he/she has to choose different 02 AECC Courses in different Two semesters (*Bengali/English/Hindi Communication in 1st Sem. and Environmental Studies in 2nd Sem.*), 04 SEC Courses (*related with DSC-1*) in different Four semesters, 02 papers each from a list of DSE courses based on the different three discipline of choice (*related with DSC-1, DSC-2 & DSC-3*) in different Two semesters during three years.
