Single Major in Physics etc). Students of 4-Year (Hons./Hons. & Research) Single Major Course will have to study 16 Single Major Papers and 04 Major Electives Papers in a particular Single Major Subject in Eight semesters.

In addition, they will have to study any 02 Subjects [maximum 01 Subject from one group of A B C D E F, as per Minor-1 and Minor-2 table, mentioned below (except the Single Major Subject)] as Minor-1 and Minor-2 alternatively in different Eight semesters, 02 AEC Courses in different Two semesters (English Communication in 1st & 3rd Sem. and Bengali/Hindi Communication in 2rd Sem. & 4th Sem.), 03 SEC Courses (related to Single Major-Hons. Subject) in different Three semesters, 03 Multidisciplinary Subjects (as per Multidisciplinary Course/Subject table*, mentioned below) in different Three semesters, 02 Value Added Courses (ENVS in 1st Sem. & Human Rights/Yoga and Wellness/ Disaster Management in 2rd Sem.), participate in 02 Summer Internship Courses in different Two semesters (one in 2rd Sem. and other in 4th Sem.) along with additional 03 Major Electives or 02 Research Papers during Four years.

In addition, they will have to study any 02 Subjects [maximum 01 Subject from one group of A B C D E F, as per Minor-1 and Minor-2 table, mentioned below (except the Single Major Subject)] as Minor-1 and Minor-2 alternatively in different Eight semesters, 02 AEC Courses in different Two semesters (English Communication in 1st & 3rd Sem. and Bengali/Hindi Communication in 2nd Sem. & 4th Sem.), 03 SEC Courses (based on Single Major-Hons. Subject) in different Three semesters, 03 Multidisciplinary Subjects (as per Multidisciplinary Course/Subject table*, mentioned below) in different Three semesters, 02 Value Added Courses (ENVS in 1st Sem. & Human Rights/Yoga and Wellness/ Disaster Management in 2nd Sem.), participate in 02 Summer Internship Courses in different Two semesters (one in 2nd Sem. and other in 4th Sem.) along with additional 03 Major Electives or 02 Research Papers during Four years.
