In which 04 Core Papers each in 02 subject (*maximum one Subject from one group of A B C D E F G, mentioned below*) and 02 Language Core Papers each in English (*in 1<sup>st</sup> Sem & 3<sup>rd</sup> Sem*) and Bengali/Hindi (*in 2<sup>nd</sup> Sem & 4<sup>th</sup> Sem.*) alternatively. In addition they have to study two papers of One Generic Subject (*other than Core Courses & Language Core Course-English/Bengali in 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Sem.*), different 02 AECC Courses in different Two semesters (*Bengali/English/Hindi Communication in 1<sup>st</sup> Sem. and Environmental Studies in 2<sup>nd</sup> Sem.*), 04 SEC Courses strictly on two subjects, taking exactly two courses from each subject (*related with DSC-1 & DSC-2*) in different Four semesters, 02 papers each from a list of DSE courses based on the different two discipline of choice (*related with DSC-1 & DSC-2*) in different Two semesters during three years.

**Students of B.Sc. General Course** have to study 12 Core Courses/papers. In which 04 Core Papers each in 03 Subjects (*maximum one Subject from one group of A B C D E F G, mentioned below*). In addition he/she has to choose different 02 AECC Courses in different Two semesters (*Bengali/English/Hindi Communication in 1<sup>st</sup> Sem. and Environmental Studies in 2<sup>nd</sup> Sem.*), 04 SEC Courses strictly on at least one from each DSC-1, DSC-2 & DSC-3 in different Four semesters, 02 papers each from a list of DSE courses based on the different three discipline of choice (*related with DSC-1, DSC-2 & DSC-3*) in different Two semesters during three years.
